1. Olympian Suresh Babu Memorial 8th Kerala State Youth Athletics Championship 2018

Olympian Suresh Babu Memorial 8th Kerala State Youth Athletics Championship was held at Chandrasekharan Nair Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram on 12th and 13th June 2018. 310 athletes



including 106 girls have participated in the meet. The championship was inaugurated Sri. T P Dasan, President, Kerala State Sports Council in a meeting presided over by Sri. Baby Mathew Somatheeram, President KSAA in the presence of Prof. S P Pillai, Chairman, Technical Committee, Athletics Federation of India, Smt. Olympian Mercy Kuttan, Vice President, Kerala State Sports Council, Sri. M Velayudhan Kutty, Former Secretary, KSAA, Sri. P Sasidharan Nair, Member, Administrative Board, KSSC, Sri. V C Alex, Vice President, KSAA and the Secretaries from various disticts.

The family of Olympian Suresh Babu declared a cash award of Rs.10000/ each to the best athletes of each category.

2. 62nd Kerala State Senior Athletics Championship 2018

Dr. Tony Daniel Memorial 62nd Kerala State Athletics Championship was held at Chandrasekharan Nair Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram on 12th and 13th June 2018. 366 athletes including 123 girls have participated in the meet. **Sri. Baby Mathew Somatheeram**, President, KSAA, presided over the meeting and welcomed the gathering. The championship was inaugurated by **Sri. T P Dasan**, President, Kerala State Sports Council.

The performance of the athlete in this meet was the main criteria for selecting the Kerala State Senior Team for the 58th National Inter State Senior Athletics Championship scheduled to be conducted at Guwahati from 26 to 29 June 2018.

3. M.K.Joseph Memorial, 15th Kerala State Inter District Club Athletics Championship 2018

The M.K.Joseph Memorial, 15th Kerala State Inter District Club Athletics Championship was originally scheduled to be held at Chandrasekharan Nair stadium, Thiruvananthapuram from 17th to 19th August 2018, but due to incessant rain, flood and landslides throughout the state of Kerala it was postponed and then conducted from 30th August to 1st June 2018.

Competitions were held for Boys and Girls Under 14 yrs, Boys and Girls Under 16 yrs, Youth Boys and Youth Girls Under 18 yrs, Junior Men and Junior Women Under 20yrs, Men and Women. 1666 athletes including 593 female athletes representing 120 clubs/Institutions from all the 14 districts have participated in this meet.

The Kerala State team which is to participate in the 30thSouth Zone Junior Athletics Championship to be held at Guntur on 15th& 16th September 2018 and the 58th National Open Athletics Championship to be held at Bhubanaswar from 25th to 28th September 2018 were selected mainly based on the performance of this meet.



The meet was inaugurated by Dr. G Kishore, Principal, LNCPE & Director, SAI (Kerala Region), in a function presided over by Dr. V C Alex, Vice President, KSAA, in the presence of Sri. 4. 62nd Kerala State Junior Athletics Championship 2018

62nd Kerala State Junior Athletics Championship was held at Chandrasekharan Nair Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram from 12 to 14 October 2018. 1506 athletes including 605 girls have participated in the meet. Lt. Dr. George Thomas, President, TDAA, welcomed the gathering. The championship was inaugurated by Sri. Dr.T I Manoj, Member of the Administrative Board of Kerala State Sports Council and DSW, Kerala Agricultural University flagged off the Cross country race.


